Three Floyds Alpha King

(Munster, IN) ABV: 6% \$6 pints Big American Pale Ale with citrusy aroma- a hop lover's cult beer and Three Floyds' flagship beer Brewed with Centennial, Cascade & Warrior Hops.

Great Lakes Dortmunder Gold

(Cleveland, OH) ABV: 5.8% \$4 Pint OUR BREWERY OF THE MONTH! This smooth lager strikes a delicate balance between malt and hops in the aroma, palate, finish and body. It has more body and less hops than a Pilsner, and less malt and more hops than a Munich style lager.

Sierra Nevada Belgian Triple

(Chico, CA) ABV: 8.5% \$6 Goblet Brewed using Rock Candi Sugar and an authentic Belgian Yeast Strain. The aromas are of coriander, banana and bubble gum. This is a very limited draft beer from Sierra Nevada.

Left Hand Milk Stout

(Longmont, CO) ABV 5.3% \$5 pint This English style of beer, also known as Sweet Stout or Cream Stout, first appeared in London in the late 1800's. The early brewers touted the health benefits of the milk sugar in this beer which today relates mainly to the increased amount of calories (no real health benefits...sorry). The milk sugar adds a well rounded sweetness to this dark beer and makes it an outstanding, year 'round stout

Southern Tier Cherry Saison

(Lakewood, NY) ABV: 8% \$5 Goblet Cherry Saison is aged with French Oak staves, imparting overtones of spice and balancing the natural sweetness of the cherries. Enjoy it as a dessert beer, or tilt it back while sitting under a shady tree on a warm summer afternoon.

Surly Furious

(Brooklyn Center, MN) ABV: 6% \$6 Pint Like Hops? You'll like this fire-hued beer with a rich malt sweetness infused with bright hop flavor.

North Coast Blue Star Wheat

(Fort Bragg, CA) ABV: 4.5% \$5 Pint Choice American barley and wheat malts are combined with a blend of noble hops to create this light, fruity, refreshing beer. Brewed in the style of the American beer renaissance, Blue Star is unfiltered, the yeast adding a complex note to the flavor profile.

Anchor Steam

(San Francisco, CA) ABV: 4.9% \$5 Pint San Francisco's famous *Anchor Steam*, the classic of American brewing tradition since 1896, is virtually handmade, with an exceptional respect for the ancient art of brewing. The deep amber color, thick creamy head, and rich flavor all testify to Anchor's traditional brewing methods.

Lagunitas New Dogtown Pale Ale

(Petaluma, CA) ABV: 6.4 % \$5 Pint The Dogtown Pale Ale has a refreshing citrus hoppiness and a slight sweetness not always found in an American Pale Ale. It's a good pick for someone who likes good hoppy bitterness but doesn't necessarily want a highly alcoholic IPA on a hot summer day

New Holland Golden Cap

(Holland, MI) ABV: 7% \$5 Pint A soft, pale beer, Golden Cap accentuates the flavors and aromas of summer fields. Brewed with an ancestor to wheat called spelt, and bottle-conditioned; it's straw-colored body accentuated with lively carbonation and unique fermentation profile evoke fresh cut hay and cracked peppercorns.

Bell's Two Hearted Ale

(Kalamazoo, MI) ABV: 7% \$5 Pint India Pale Ale style with American malts and enormous hop additions give this beer a crisp finish and incredible floral hop aroma.

Founders Cerise

(Grand Rapids, MI) ABV: 6.5% \$7 Goblet Using only fresh Michigan tart cherries, this beauty tantalizes with intense flavors combined with a no hesitation malt bill Adding fresh cherries at five separate stages of fermentation achieves the ultimate balance between tartness and bitterness.

Three Floyds Gumballhead

(Munster, IN) ABV: 4.8% \$6 Pint Refreshing summertime wheat ale gently hopped with a very citrus grapefruit character.

Allagash White

(Portland ME) ABV 5% \$6 Pint Brewed with a generous portion of wheat and our own special blend of spices, this beer is light and slightly cloudy in appearance, with a spicy aroma.

Great Lakes Burning River

(Cleveland, OH) ABV 6% \$4 Pint OUR BREWERY OF THE MONTH!!! An assertively hopped American Pale Ale with citrus and pine flavored cascade hops.

Half Acre Daisy Cutter Pale Ale

(Chicago, IL) ABV: 5.2% \$5 Pint Daisy Cutter Pale Ale is a West Coast Strong Pale Ale, focusing on the aromatic qualities of the hops. A master blend of five different hops creates a powerful nose and a dynamic flavor.

Goose Island Matilda

(Chicago, IL) ABV 7% \$7 Goblet Made with a rare yeast that suggests a fruity and spicy flavor. There is complex maltiness balanced with a profuse amount of hops.

Magic Hat #9

(South Burlington, VT) ABV: 4.6% \$5 Pint -A crisp, fruity, refreshing, not-quite pale ale.

Pabst Blue Ribbon

(Milwaukee, WI) ABV: 5% \$3 Pint A Classic American Macro Lager.
